To redeem their prize, the winners must visit centre management (during office hours) with the winning scratch card.

PART A – INTRODUCTION

1. All prizes are to be claimed from the Centre Management, with proof of purchase receipt dated between selected timeframe, valid ID and valid scratchy card issued by CHOP CHOP Surfers Paradise.

PART F – UNCLAIMED PRIZES
